## Car Parking Charges

### NEWPORT COMMUNITY MEETING

We the undersigned people hereby convene a meeting of the Town of Newport Pembrokeshire pursuant to section 27(1) Local Government Act 1972 for the purpose of discussing community affairs and in particular the present proposal by Pembrokeshire County Council to extend parking charges to a car park in Newport.

The Town Meeting will be conducted in accordance with Schedule 12 Part V Local Government Act 1972.

The Town Meeting is convened by six (6) local government Electors of the Town represented by Newport Town Council.

The Town Meeting will take place on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2010 at the Memorial Hall at 7:00pm seven clear days notice having been given.
