MINUTES: The Minutes of the meeting held on the 27th October 2008 were proposed and seconded as correct by Cllrs. Sue Hutchinson & John Rowe Lewis.

MATTERS

ARISING: Cllr. Dai Webb confirmed that he would be meeting Mrs. Bayes shortly to revise and update information on the website.

The Chairman reported that the Spring Bay Festival no longer have a key for the changing rooms.

The N/P and CADW have still to confirm a date for a joint meeting to discuss future maintenance of the old castle site.

Cllr. Sue Hutchinson has made preliminary enquiries about using the field and changing rooms for tent camping in the summer months, and will give the meeting more information next month.

Cllr. Dilys Evans reported riders exercising their horses in the Playing Field and said perhaps we should have a sign made stating both horses and dogs must not be exercised in the field. There is an official no dogs sign, and it was felt horse riders should be aware playing fields were not meant for horses. All Trustees were asked to speak to anyone using the field inappropriately, and if they can be identified a letter will be sent to them and/or their parents.

The annual insurance premium is due to be paid early in December, and it was agreed to renew the policy as soon as the invitation is received.
